

Government Language Training

Our government programs focus on student success in the Government of Canada second language evaluation exams. We also offer programs for provincial, municipal and other employees. Our teaching formats include private, semi-private and group. The following is an overview of the programs we offer:

Private

Private classes work best for students that need to learn quickly by providing them the individual attention they need. A primary teacher is assigned based on the student objectives and learning style, and secondary teachers assist by providing specialized expertise, variety, and exposure to different accents and oral styles. We have program templates for students striving for specific objectives such as BBB or CBC. These templates are starting points, and we revise individual student programs depending on our detailed assessments, brief weekly reviews, and more thorough monthly reviews.

Semi-Private

Semi-private classes are a cost effective alternative to private classes, and are most successful when both students have similar language objectives, learning styles, and timeframes. The format provides a high level of individual student attention, and students often benefit from working as a team. Each student has an individual learning plan, which is regularly reviewed and revised as necessary.

Group Classes

This is a very popular option for people who are working to maintain their language abilities or working towards higher proficiency levels on a limited budget. Students often supplement group classes with private classes and/or self-study to accelerate learning. Group classes are very good for improving oral skills, as students can pair up and work on specific exercises and share learning strategies with each other. We offer these classes on-site at various government departments, as well as to individuals in our classrooms on weekday evenings. Classes are offered at each language level in both English and French.

Intensive/Immersion

Our full time immersion program provides a high degree of French interaction to accelerate language acquisition. Programs are customized depending on student availability, objectives, and timeframes. Additional options may include local trips, weekend classes, and homestays.

Supported Self-Directed

This program is well suited to motivated students with limited funding and/or limited daytime availability. It works well for students who are working primarily on their written and comprehension exams. Our structured program includes workbooks, CDs, and other materials. The teacher regularly reviews student performance, answers student questions, and gives a lesson in required areas.

Distance Education

We offer a program for students who cannot or prefer not to attend classes in person. Using an online application, we teach French with interactive audio, video, chat, notes, and screen sharing. This option allows students to learn French from a location convenient to them.
