

Other Language Training

Overview

We offer a wide range of language training options from structured group classes to customized lessons for individuals and groups. We teach students of all ages, abilities and levels, designing programs to fit student language needs such as for work, travel, or family. We track student progress to ensure all aspects of learning plans are effective, and make changes as appropriate. We have taught a variety of students including young actors on location, schoolteachers wanting to deliver more engaging French teaching, and people learning other languages including Spanish and German.

Programs

Group Classes

Our popular group classes focus on building speaking confidence and are offered at starter, beginner, intermediate, and advanced levels. Students may begin classes at any time, and maximum class size is six students to ensure students have a high level of interaction. The following is the current group class schedule:

Winter Term: January 2, 2012 to March 9, 2012 (10 weeks)
Spring Term: March 19, 2012 to June 15, 2012 (13 weeks)
Summer Term: July 2, 2012 to August 24, 2012 (8 weeks)
Fall Term: September 3, 2012 to December 14, 2012 (15 weeks)
Winter Term: January 1, 2013 to March 8, 2013 (10 weeks)

Private and Semi-Private

We offer specialized programs tailored to student needs. We have developed a 10 level certification program, with separate assessments at each level for reading, writing, and oral abilities. We use this program as the starting point for assessments, in establishing objectives, and in teaching and measuring progress. We have a wide range of teaching materials to suit student learning styles and make learning more engaging and effective.

Customized

We can design and deliver a program to suit your individual or group program requirements. Some of our teachers have additional specialized training to teach students with special needs, including those with dyslexia or with hearing, speech or vision impairments.

Location and Pricing

Classes are normally taught in our classrooms in Kanata, however we also teach at other locations across Ottawa as mutually agreed. Pricing is on a per-hour basis based on students per class, language objectives, total hours, and training location.

Alternatives

We also offer programs tailored to government language training needs, business language training needs, and children's tutoring. For students who cannot or prefer not to attend classes in person we offer a web based program. Using an online application, we teach French with interactive audio, video, chat, notes, and screen sharing. This option allows students to learn French from a location convenient to them.
